# Guidelines for submission of abstracts

Deadline: 5 December, 2016

HRI welcome's abstracts for oral and poster presentations from researchers, post-graduate students/research trainees, homeopathy practitioners and educators.

Following peer review, guided by HRI's Scientific Advisory Committee, submissions of a sufficiently high standard will be accepted either for an oral presentation or poster presentation.

Please note that we do not provide individual feedback on submissions.

Results will be announced in early February 2017.

As we are looking to present snapshots of people's latest work, we will be having a mixture of short and longer presentations (i.e. 15, 30 and 45 minute durations, including questions). We therefore encourage submission of recently published, or as yet unpublished findings.

Word count: 300 words excluding title and key terms.

### **Suitable topics**

We are accepting abstracts fitting the theme of 'Cutting Edge Research' i.e. with an emphasis on the latest developments across the various sub-fields of homeopathy research. Suitable topics include:

- Clinical research (quantitative, qualitative or mixed methods)
- Disease prevention
- · Fundamental research
- · Health services research
- In vitro animal and plant-based research
- Pathogenetic trials
- · Research methodology
- · Veterinary research

N.B. Abstracts relating to animal research projects must not only have received ethical approval, but also be in line with EU ethical guidelines.

As this is not an exhaustive list, if you wish to submit on a different topic and are unsure whether it is suitable, please email us at abstracts@homeoinst.org and we will be happy to advise you.

# **Submission procedure**

As our online submission system is now live, abstracts will no longer be accepted by email. Please submit your abstract via the conference website at www.HRIMalta2017.org/abstracts.

#### **Bookings and further information**

Those selected to make an **oral or poster presentation will receive a 10% discount on their conference fee**. Presenters must register by **1 April 2017** at the latest. However, as places are strictly limited, we recommend that you book at the earliest opportunity (see **www.HRIMalta2017.org**).

If you are selected to make a presentation at a later date, the fee reduction will be applied retrospectively as a refund. Presenters are responsible for their own travel, accommodation and all other expenses.
